Practice Gaps

- The vast majority of general anesthesiologists currently perform regional anesthesia techniques without ultrasound guidance. A recent analysis of the ASA Closed Claims Database revealed that the most common claims for injury in the 2000s have been related to regional anesthesia. This program will help to address the apparent knowledge gap leading to these injuries.
- Maternal and neonatal death/severe injury related to substandard anesthesia care continue to be a major problem, according to a recent analysis of the ASA Closed Claims Database. A review of the latest advancements in obstetrical anesthesia will help address this knowledge gap.
- Current national drug shortages significantly impact the scope and safety of the practice of anesthesia. Anesthesiologists are forced to provide care with an increasingly limited and ever changing armamentarium of drugs.

Learning Objectives

- Use live, ultrasound simulation to learn safe techniques for the administration of regional anesthesia.
- Assess the current state of regional and national political affairs as they relate to the practice of anesthesia.
- Describe several of the new anticoagulant medications and list some of their anesthetic implications.
- Describe the latest updates in providing safe obstetrical anesthesia care.
- Explain how best to care for recipients of solid organ transplants in non-transplant surgery.
- Assess the current drug shortage situation and explain the role of the Food and Drug Administration in monitoring/regulating pharmaceutical supply chains.
